January- We planned a Vacation Bible School for 3 nights, Sunday through Tuesday. Our theme was "The Right Way". We compared the right and wrong ways of baking a cake, applying for a job and of taking care of our teeth. Each lesson was compared to the way the Christian needs to do right and not let sin destroy their lives. We had a Baker, a Phycologist and a Dentist from our church present the physical side and Rogerio presented the spiritual side of "The Right Way". The adults were using the hot glue gun, doing the handcraft and participating in the activities. We even had a special cake made to celebrate Bill's birthday a few days late.
