Because of damage to old walls we had to replace three walls we did not plan on which through the work behind and greatly increased the cost of the construction. We are grateful that the group finished the walls and roof of the new addition. We hope to finish the roof on the old part by next week and start plastering the walls. Even in this condition we are using it as Sunday school when it isn't raining.

The men's conference went very well. There were men from the capital city, Western Honduras as well as Siguatepeque. I enjoyed teaching it and appreciate Leslie's hard work in organizing and administering it. Your prayers brought many blessings and results.

Next week we will be working on the legal papers with our son David to get permission to take Litza to the states. They had their marriage ceremony here in the church in May but she couldn't go to the states with him until immigration gives the legal paper work, a very long hard process, which we hope can be finished at the American Embassy next Tuesday and as the Lord answers prayer she will be able to go to live with David the first of December.

I am teaching and preaching in the mission work in Barrio Carmen and Lena is giving lessons to the Ladies in Colonia Matta each Friday afternoon. This week I had to repair our generator, help with church construction, secretarial and bookkeeping in the office, and visitation. We are praying that maybe someone would come down and help with our ministries in Honduras. Thank you for your prayers that keeps all this and us going.
