The Lord was good during youth camp. He blessed with a good spirit and cooperation. A man that was saved last year at youth camp came back with his wife as counselors this year. It is always exciting to see our son, Leslie, lead youth camp as well as teach and preach in it. Pastor Daniel taught and preached also and I preach and helped with the activity. Leslie and Daniel were teens in our first youth camp 38 years ago. The activity for three days was to go to the home for the elderly that don't have family that can take care of them and work three hours a day cleaning. There are not retirement homes here and a doctor built this home for needy elderly that did not have family or means to care for themselves. Since there is very little help for the home it was greatly neglected. The teens cleaned windows, kitchen, bathrooms, drainage ditches and a incinerator that was plugged up. They hugged the elderly and gave them love that they don't get. It was wonderful.

Lena and I with another missionary couple, Mike and Martha Rudd, gave a three hour class on Friday of Holy Week to the deaf and their family. There was a lesson and movie about Jesus' death, burial and resurrection with hand crafts and demonstrations to help them understand clearly.

Our youngest grandson, Edgar, is getting married to Alexandra Orellana April 26th here in Siguatepeque. We are very excited about this, they already bought a house and the wedding will take place in the back yard, I will be officiating.
