It has been a great month. We recently had two saved, older people who needed the Lord. They were good Catholics but had never heard the Gospel.

We were blessed to be able to have two home services this month. We are trying to reach out further spread the Good News.

The poverty level is at about 95% in Honduras, the need is great. The mission received some special offerings from another country, a family of members of the mission work. This made it possible to help six families of our mission work that have great needs. We provided large baskets of food.

In November I preached in two works each week. We also had five services a week in the mission work and hope to start a Bible Study soon in order to help the people grow in the Lord and train leaders.

We are supporting the deaf ministry of missionaries Mike and Martha Rudd. They use the Bible institute buildings three times a week and we let the leading deaf family live in a small apartment that we have for free. God has blessed and it is a strong ministry.

Thanksgiving was a good time with my son, Leslie and oldest grandson, Steve. Leslie cooked the turkey and made apple pie. I cooked the mashed potatoes, candied yams, and a pumpkin pie. All was very good. Not bad for a couple of bachelors. We sure miss our wives.

Halbert was raised in Honduras and Iliana was born in the US but raised in Southern Mexico with her family. She came back to the US to study and work where she met Halbert in Dallas Texas.

While in Mexico we will visit missionary friend Darrain Coker and his family. Darrain stayed with Leslie in Honduras for a time getting to know the mission work.
