Four young men who just three years ago were roaming the streets of Ulan Bator, Mongolia without direction or purpose in life until one cold winter's night wandered into the church that Holger Grime started and found the Lord and their lives were changed. Now fresh out of Bible school they visited us and their excitement is contagious as they return to start new Mongolian churches. I call them our new life preaching trio. Pray for them and for Mongolia!

2011 is a very important year in the life of born again Christians in Spain. Back in 1962 the Religious Liberty Law was passed by the Spanish government. For the first time in modern history non Catholic churches were allowed to operate without fear of being closed down. Now years later this freedom is being challenged by groups similar to the U.S. ACLU. The government is going to take up this issue in early Spring. The most controversial point of the Bill before parliament will probably be the regulation of the use of Christian Crosses and or Symbols on churches and public buildings during ceremonies.

Lastly let us remember the plans for "Bible fresh" headed up by the Bible Society to coincide with the 400th anniversary celebration of the KING JAMES BIBLE this year!
