Changes in Infrustructure

The mission church property is located in an area that is amongst the poorest in the Dominican Republic, Average income is \$2.00 U.S. per person daily. We are privileged to experience many changes for the better since the mission began. Of course the most important thing is the many changed lives we have been blessed to see. Beyond that, we are seeing changes in the infrastructure that will





make life less of a daily struggle. The existing raw sewage emptying into streams nearby is being replaced with a city sewage system. When the sewage lines are connected we will proceed with the building of a bathroom on the mission property. We thank those who have donated funds to begin the work. We are trusting the Lord for an additional \$1000 US. to complete the project. There are five miles of rough dirt roads leading up to the mission. This will soon be changing! These roads will soon be paved! That means no more walking in sticky mud to get to church services. We are praying that 2 014 will be a time of great change in the lives of the beloved Dominican people. We thank the Lord for your steadfast obedience to the Great Commission and your sincere interest in the souls of the Dominican people.
