KARIN'S HEALTH UPDATE

Karin found a lump on her breast. She went to her primary physician and he ordered a Mammogram. The results came back abnormal. So, he ordered a Diagnostic Mammogram with an Ultrasound. The tests still came back abnormal. The next step was a Needle Biopsy. The results of the biopsy were cancerous. A few days later, she had a MRI exam and it showed another lump. The next step was another needle biopsy on the second lump. The results were cancerous. So, on June 19th, Karin was admitted into the Hospital in San Antonio, Tx. The Surgeon and his team were able to extract the 2 cancerous lumps and also remove 2 lymph nodes to find out if they were cancerous. The Lymph Nodes exam came back normal. So that meant that the cancer had not spread. Praise the Lord!!! She has to wait until the surgery heals completely and then the next step is Chemotherapy or Radiation.
