Second Robbery – I am embarrassed to say that twelve days after our robbery in Brazil, we were again hit while in a hotel room in Saint Augustine, Florida. We had just stepped out for a bite to eat, and were only about 200 feet away, and thieves broke into the room and took both our laptops, personal items, travel documents, and some of Diana's clothes. They also took my preaching Bible and sermons. I would like to thank the churches and individuals that have so graciously given so that we could replace the items, and get new documents. This was a great encouragement, as we were very discouraged. In the briefcases were all our passwords, accounts, personal information, so Diana has been struggling through that again, after the first robbery.

Return to Brazil – Our plans are to return May 5th, if we can get all the necessary documents by then. We need to return and relieve Tim and Betty, and get back to our work. There are many things to do and little time left.

Prayer and Thanks – Please continue to pray for us. I believe we are being attacked because we're on the right track. Thank you for your love and concern, all the phone calls and emails. It is very important to us to know that people are standing with us. We appreciate each and every one of you and your ministry of missions.
