We Still Need Revival

Someone submitted the following outline on how to know when Revival happens. Taken from what happened at Jerusalem on the day of Pentecost in Acts 2, one pre-dominant mark of revival is not a sense of feeling spiritual, but rather, an overwhelming sense of our sinfulness. The four characteristics that evidence a revival are: 1) A definite outpouring of God's Spirit, 2) Bold preachers of the Gospel, 3) Audiences smitten with conviction, and 4) Great numbers added to the church. That is what every church needs today. It started for the disciples after they were obedient in doing what they had already been instructed to do. They were waiting in the appointed place, they all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication; then Peter stood up and caused them to do what they knew they should do in choosing Matthias to take the place of Judas. In God's time, revival came. May we follow their example of obedience and faith, and then expect God to send us Revival.
