An Unreached People

Yes, there are billions of people outside the USA who have not heard of our Savior; but even sadder are those within our own country who do not know Him. Who will tell them? Crown Southwest/Norris Seminary has partnered with Worth Baptist Church to run two Good News Clubs in two public elementary schools. The door is not shut, although one day it probably will be. These children are an unreached people who would believe if they had that opportunity. We get into the schools through Child Evangelism Fellowship. Once in the school, the children's parents (who are grateful for the Bible Club) keep us there. We had an enrollment of 145 children and an average attendance of 108 at North Elementary this past October. At Blue Haze Elementary, we had an enrollment of 107 with an average attendance of 83. The Lord asked in His Word, "who will go for us?" May we seize the opportunity "while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work." The Lord admonishes us, "pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest."

I get asked a few questions about the Bible Clubs.

- Does CEF have Bible curriculum in KJV? Yes, they do. It is what we use. CEF also provides training on "how to" run a Bible Club.
- Is it legal? Yes, the Supreme Court ruled in favor of Good News Clubs to meet in the public schools in 2001. It is an after school program.
- How do I get started? Pray about which school God would have you work.
