The first service of Eaton Baptist Temple was held at the Fort St. Clair Park on September 5, 1961. There were 26 people in attendance.

The church was organized October 29, 1961, with 29 charter members. Rev. John (Jack) Frost was elected as the first pastor. As cold weather approached services were moved to the Fairgrounds. The first phase of our church building was started in April 1963. The first formal service was held at our present location, 416 East Decatur Street, Eaton, OH on Thanksgiving Day in November of 1963.

Pastor John Frost resigned in 1962 and Rev. Lynn Randall became pastor. Rev. Randall pastored Eaton Baptist Temple until 1966 when he accepted a call to the Temple Baptist Church, New Castle, IN.



Pastor Lowell T. Spencer accepted this pastorate in December 1966 and he has remained pastor until the present time. With additional growth more space was needed and the 305 Aukerman Street property was purchased in 1974.

Our pastor had a burden for a Christian School and Preble Christian Academy was born in 1975, serving our community for 20 years with Christian Education. Eaton Baptist Temple has also been a "Mission Minded Church" and we presently support 87 Mission projects at home

and abroad, "The Sun Never Sets on the Ministry of the Eaton Baptist Temple". God has blessed us with four additional lots (to the west of us) on the corner of Lincoln and Decatur Streets, which is used for additional parking.

Through these "55 years" many people have been reached with the Gospel, (saved and baptized). God has called a number of folks into full-time service of the Lord. Pastor Spencer and Eaton Baptist Temple have been an active part of IBFI since its very beginning, financially and through attendance. Pastor Spencer has served as a board member.

On November 20, 2016 Eaton Baptist Temple celebrated her 55th Anniversary and Pastor Spencer celebrated his 50th year as pastor of Eaton Baptist Temple. Bro. Spencer and Carol say, in view of it all, "We look forward to the blessings of the Lord in the future here at Eaton Baptist Temple. Our motive is the same and the message is the same. To God Be the glory! Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and forever!"

Through the years, Bro. Spencer has been a very steady supporter of the Norris Bible Baptist Seminary! He was one of the founding pastors and is always quick to respond personally and through his church to needs of the school when an appeal goes out. Most recently, he was among the first to get on board with the fund raising effort for new floor covering at the Ray Richey Building that houses the seminary and the IBFI mission office.

Bro. Marvin Weido, after 48 years as a pastor and evangelist, went home to be with the Lord, Wednesday, November 23, 2016. He was 82 years of age.

He was among the many preachers in 1984 that were a part of the founding of the IBFI and the Norris Bible Baptist Seminary. At the time he was the pastor of the Southside Baptist Church of Arlington, Texas. It was a church he had founded in 1970. He remained, for many years, a strong supporter of Norris Bible Baptist Seminary and IBFI missionaries.

Marvin was born September 23, 1934 in Cameron, Texas. He graduated from Sharp High School in 1953, and joined the Army in 1955. From 1957-1964 he served as a Texas State Trooper. He, along with his wife Jean, accepted Christ as his savior the last Sunday of August, 1966 under the preaching of Dr. Claud Bonam Sr., pastor of the Huisache Avenue Baptist Church of San Antonio, Texas. He surrendered to preach under the ministry of Dr. John Duckett at Helmers Street Baptist Church in Houston, Texas. He moved his family to the Fort Worth area to attend the Bible Baptist seminary. Both he and his wife graduated from the school in 1972.

Bro. Weido was well-beloved by many preachers and befriended many not just in word but in deed. He was self-sacrificing and a mentor of many young preachers. He lived to see children and grandchildren, for many years, busy serving the Lord. His wife passed away several years ago, and at the time of his death he was married to Allie Weido, who was also a devoted wife. His two sons, Pastor J.D. Weido and Bob Weido have for many years worked alongside each other in the Bible Baptist Church of El Dorado, AR; a church J.D. started in 1992. J.D. is an alumnus of NBBS.
