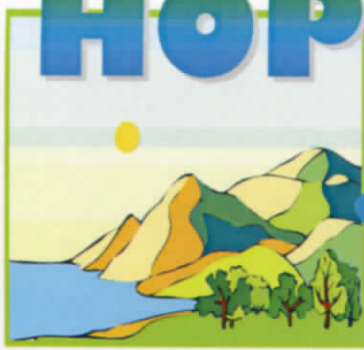


HOPE for Honduras!
