September-October 2025

SEPTEMBER- We had 13 at the Pastors Breakfast here in Boa Vista at Pastor Werlesson's church. Bread, cake, coffee, juice and fruits. We also discussed various subjects and each Pastor gave a report about their church and how things were going.



September 25th was the last service for **Ipojucan e Vaudimarian** because they were moving to the Northeast of Brasil. They have been faithful to the Alvorada church and will be greatly missed. They are both retired and want to travel while they can. They have an apartment in the Northeast and rented out their house here in Boa Vista.

OCTOBER - On the 3rd we mailed our current Passports to the American Consulate in Rio de Janeiro, Brasil, to be renewed. They will expire in April of 2026. We wanted to receive the new ones without waiting too long. It could take up to 4 to 6 weeks or longer.

On the 8th we had a bad storm with lightening, thunder and heavy rains. This must have been the last storm of the year which we usually have in August or September. Praise the Lord we didn't lose power and everything was safe.

On October 11th, Pastor Rogerio and Zipora, had a special time with the children of the Bible Baptist Church in Boa Vista. Do you know what the verse says in English? This is the Portuguese version of the verse from the Bible found in Psalm 119:105.





10th-12th was the 47th Anniversary of the Bible Baptist Church in Caracarai that we started. Hard to believe it has been 47 years. We praise the Lord for the faithfulness of the people. We saw children and grandchildren of the children that we taught back in 1978 when we started the church. It was good to see a lot of young adult couples helping with the activities, the songs, the cleaning up after and just a good spirit. The Pastors wife asked me to teach the lesson for the special Children's Program they had there on the 11th. I told her it had been a while since I had taught a lesson but I would try. I taught about the theme: "Where did we come from? Where are we now? Where are we going?" Creation, Birth, Death and Resurrection of Christ and a home in Heaven if they are saved.

They still had a song that I had made 47 years ago: "Who made the beautiful stars, the birds that fly, the blue sea. Who made you and me? God our Father. It was great to see that song after 47 years.
