Cyclone Freddy was the longest-living and strongest cyclone in history.

- It hit Mozambique and Malawi on March 1
- Left in its wake over 1000+ dead.
- More than 500,000 homeless.
- Many of these came from very remote areas that were difficult to access with the gospel.
- These People are now being housed in government camps.
- They are now accessible for the gospel.

Why does this matter?

Opportunities to get the gospel out are all around us. It is easy to overlook them; because we are not looking for them. Our opinion would tell us it is not worth the effort.

But our thoughts are not God's thoughts! We should pray and watch expectantly God will open doors.

What can you do?
