We are relatively new to medical missions endeavors, but have quickly learned the ropes from more experienced friends in Texas, over the last few years. Recently a national pastor in Retalhuleu contacted us, requesting our help for a large medical team that his ministry had invited to come into the country, and to provide translation for them during their medical mission. We were happy to use what we've learned to help them, and it was a very successful week of ministry together. People came from all around the area for medical, dental, and eye care, every one hearing the Gospel presented, and each day attendance doubled. The final count was 1744 people treated, with about 700 professions of faith. About half of the translators were from our church, and many of us came away with wonderful testimonies of how the Lord met the physical and spiritual needs of those we met and personally ministered to in Retalhuleu. Praise the Lord!

I've been in touch with the team from Heritage Baptist Church in Haslet, Texas, and they are planning to return to Guatemala in July of 2025. We look forward to working with them again, and we appreciate your prayers for us as we prepare.
