
Gun Fire: Just as our second day of family camp was to end some counselors told me to go to the eastern part of the camp and listen, and sure enough there was gun fire some ways



off. Then that night, there was gun fire off to the west of us and more gunfire to the east and much closer! We sent the campers to bed and the counselors prayed while we got buses to come for us at 8 a.m. the next morning. By 10 a.m. that place was deserted and we were all home safe by 11 that morning.

**Wild Fires:** At the same time, fires started breaking out on the mountains that surround Monterrey. More than 50 wild fires sprung up around the mountains of Monterrey, due mainly to the very dry season (no rain since October of last year). We have already had temperatures of 110 degrees!

Revival Fires: But despite the wild fires and the gunfire, God sent us revival! Michael Jones, our son, pictured to the right, was saved, baptized, called to preach and graduated from our institute. He came down from Fort Worth where he is the youth director for the New Horizons Baptist Church (Javier Garza, a graduate of our institute and my son-in-law is the pastor) to preach our family camp. God used him in a tremendous way. He preached two nights at the camp site and two nights at our church with an average of 195 in attendance, 1 saved, two called to preach and many fixing their family problems! We have had baptisms every service since camp and there is a great spirit of unity in the works here in Monterrey! In Bethesda alone, we have had 97 saved during soul-winning efforts, 4 saved during the services and 7 baptized! In the picture to the right I am baptizing Jorge Tello. The revival has not been on a local level alone, but we have added 4 missionaries to our mission family, and now have 68 missionaries that Bethesda supports at 40 dollars a month plus the 5 home missionaries that are supported at 400 dollars a month!
