March, 2018: Is it worth training a worker?


Dear Praying Friends,

One of the greatest blessings of training others is teaching them that they can achieve great things through Christ our Lord. Teaching is giving others the tools to start, and then watching them be used of God in many ways. We are personally training 11 men through 2 Institutes here in the Valley; and through the 15 other Bible Institutes that have been started, hundreds are being trained!

In March, I went to Oklahoma and visited Arturo Quiñiones (pictured to the right), graduate #34 of Bible Institute #1, who has started two churches and a Bible Institute (#8). As he was proudly showing me his church facility, he was quick to point out the efforts they are making to win the Hispanic community for Christ. They have won several “illegals” to Christ, trained them in the Bible Institute, and sent them back to Oaxaca, Mexico as missionaries! It is worth it!



In March, Otoniel Gómez (pictured to the left), graduate #35 of Bible Institute #1 made me an author! He took our Sunday school notes from Galatians to Colossians and made a book, not to sell, but to give to pastors in Guatemala and Honduras so they could have some good,



doctrinally sound materials! He printed the book at a cost of \$3.00 per book and he did it all out of his own pocket and sent me 15 to give away! Otoniel has started one church, one Bible institute in Guatemala, and two printing ministries, one in Guatemala and one in Honduras! It is worth it!



In April, I received a letter from Joel Vázquez, graduate #94 from Bible Institute #1) and gave me his testimony: *“I was saved in the First Fundamental Baptist Church as a child (the first church my dad, C. L. Jones started). Years later God moved me to Bethesda Baptist of Monterrey, where God called me to preach. I was married in 1994, and for ten years had been the music director of one of the missions of the church and a lay preacher there. I entered the institute in 2013 and graduated in 2017 having helped in the Bible Clubs for children, bus routes, evangelistic campaigns, and teaching Sunday school from children to adult classes at*

different times in the church. Now I am pastoring the Jordan Baptist Church in García, N.L. In the last five months, several have been saved, 10 baptized and two are awaiting baptism now! We are having a good problem: no room in our present facilities. Keep our work in your prayers!” (We have written about this work before. Bro. Aristeo Canales used to pastor there, but had to resign because of his health. We praise the Lord that the work continues under a new vision and a new worker!) It is worth it!

Update on our family’s health: Danny Jr., our son, has found out that his problem is possibly from his migraine headaches and not Meniere’s disease! Praise the Lord! I got to spend some time with Mateo, our 14th grandson in the hospital in March, when I was coming back home. He has not had a seizure for over a month now! Hallelujah! Thanks to all of you who have been praying for him and for Danny, Jr. We are blessed with wonderful prayer-warriors!
