It will be measured from time to time and depending on its development, he might need open heart surgery. Please keep this little "miracle baby" in your prayers. her children with us during Vacation Bible School!)

Michelle got back from the fellowship meeting and immediately got sick. She had pneumonia, and then an allergic reaction to one of the medicines, which caused her to faint in the kitchen floor! We rushed her to the hospital where she started having convulsions! While in the hospital she got C-diff, and was also diagnosed with epilepsy! She is over her pneumonia and the C-diff, and is on medication for her epilepsy. We also found out that she had been wrongfully diagnosed with rheumatoid arthritis by a doctor who is now in jail for fraud! I (Danny, Sr.) got strep throat the day VBS started at our church! I am better now and trying to catch up. So, we have had a strenuous May, June and beginning of July, but through it all, the grace of God has allowed us to reach people that otherwise we would not have ever witnessed to.
