Dear Praying Friends,

In our last letter, we told you we had 3 graduate from the institute in Monterrey. What has the Institute done since 1980 when it was founded, and where are the students now? So far, this is what we have seen:

Multiplication of Graduates Serving The Lord: 99 have graduated since 1984, our first graduating class! Where are they now? Well, at last count, 58 are serving the Lord either full time or part time. Besides them, 2 full time workers have gone to be with the Lord, and 1 full time worker has had to retire because of ill health. There are 3 students that we do not know about, 3 that are discouraged and have quit serving the Lord and 32 that are serving in their local churches as lay people.

Multiplication Of Places In Which Our Graduates Serve The Lord: most of the 58 serve in México, but 1/3 of our graduates are missionaries serving in Argentina (1), Guatemala (1), Korea (1), Panamá (2), Perú (1), Poland (1), Spain (1), Taiwan (1), USA (9)! (Note: all 9 in the US are here legally and serving Hispanics in New York, Oklahoma, and Texas!) There are 5 more graduates that are on deputation going to different countries!

Multiplication of Institutes Started by Graduates: 17 other Bible Institutes started! Our graduates have gone out, started churches, and then in their churches have started institutes so that they in turn can go out and start other churches and institutes. Your ministry is multiplying!
