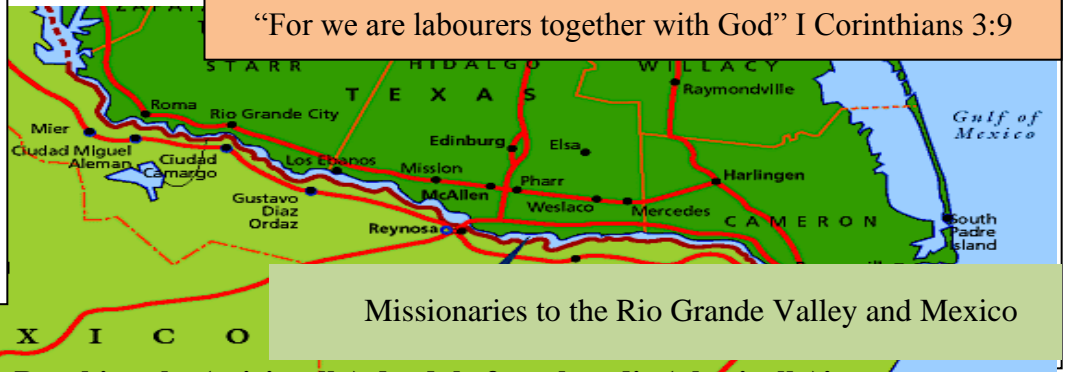

Dear Praying Friends,

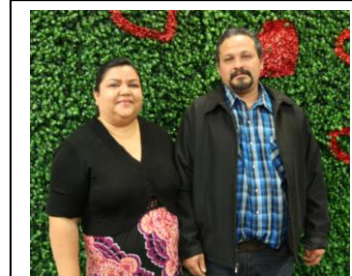
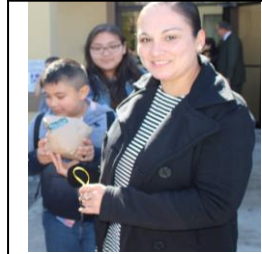
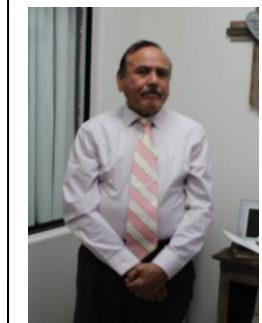
During the months of March and April, the Lord has allowed us to reach out to many people, in spite of the Coronavirus. I think we have seen more people saved during this time, than any other time in our ministry here in the Rio Grande Valley.

Funeral of Porfirio Gutierrez, brother of Ruben Gutierrez. This funeral was right before the covid-19 crisis hit, and we had **3 saved!** Ruben was saved and baptized under our ministry, and ever since, he has endeavored to win his family to the Lord. Last year I had the privilege of winning one of his sisters to the Lord one week before she died! Porfirio was won over the phone two days before he died!

Funeral of Rosalinda Villarreal. I had the privilege of winning this lady to the Lord two years ago. She was Linda Villarreal’s mom. Linda was the first person saved in our ministry here in the Valley! I was at Rosalinda’s bedside when she went home to be with the Lord. During that funeral, **4 people were saved!** This funeral was conducted just as the crisis started.

Funeral of Santos Perez. Santos died during the stay at home orders. One of her family members had been at Rosalinda’s funeral when I preached and mentioned to Linda that she would like for me to visit her sick mother (Santos). She had had a stroke, and by the time they asked me to go see her, she was in a coma. We witnessed to her, and our hope is that she was able to understand and trust Christ as her Savior. The good news is that **two of her daughters, a son and a daughter-in-law were saved!** The funeral seemed so strange since only 10 were allowed in the funeral home.

The salvation of Alberto Vela was a wonderful experience. He had been coming to church for three months before the Coronavirus crisis hit. Every time I tried to witness to him, something would happen and we would either have to cancel the visit or we would be interrupted to the point we could not get back on the subject of salvation. Now that work has slowed down, I was able to get a meeting with him for Monday the 27th of April, but my car would not start! Michelle was at a Doctor’s appointment in the other car (our granddaughter Andrea drives her). I thought, here we go again! My appointment with Alberto was for 9 am, I did not get there until 2:30 pm., but he was patiently waiting and was **gloriously saved!**
