Merry Christmas from the C. L. Jones memorial fund: We thank God for those who support this fund, because it enables our works to buy, build and do the legal work for their respective churches. Since dad's death, this fund has made it possible to help two churches on three different occasions.

Merry Christmas from the Instituto Bautista Fundamental: One of a missionary's job is to multiply and produce fruit after their own kind. Arnulfo Olivo, a graduate of our institute in Monterrey, went to Panama as a missionary. There he stared 4 churches and an institute. A young man by the name of Joel Mina graduated from that institute. In Monterrey, Yarelly, a girl from our church graduated from our institute. She met Joel on a missions trip to Panama, and to make a long story short: they married and are now on deputation, going to Uruguay as missionaries! Missions is all about training others to continue to do the work God has called us to do! Pray for the 16 institutes that have been started in 5 different countries!

Merry Christmas from the Iglesia Bautista Betesda of McAllen: In the last two months, we have had 8 saved. We had 3 baptized in September and have many more to be baptized in the following months! We had been running 100 in Sunday School before the pandemic, and just this month we reached 100 once again! Our greatest month was the month of October, in which our people pledged to give 30,000 to missions in 2021-2022! We now support 34 missionaries! As of this writing, we are trying to get the permits to remodel a building we purchased in August. We started the paperwork to remodel what once was a bar into a church building in September. In October the papers went from the county to the health department. They sat there for two months despite our insistence on the progress of the paperwork. We just found out that we now must have a septic tank inspection and approval by the county in order to move forward to the fire department. I meet with the inspector today (Friday the 24th of Dec.); he said he would try to get it done by the first week of January. Please pray! We are excited about the prospect of being in our own place soon, and we thank God for the **Jehovah-Jireh Ministries** that will make the remodeling financially possible!

Merry Christmas from the works that we have established throughout the years in Mexico: The churches in Mexico are rebounding from covid. Though attendance is still limited somewhat by the government, souls are being saved, baptized, & trained in the local churches. They continue to support missions and are actively engaged in going out and winning souls.
