We ended 2021 and started 2022 with Covid! We praise God that neither of us had to be hospitalized, though with Michelle's physical conditions, we were really concerned, but God was gracious. We thank Him for four of our men that took care of the preaching during that time. In 2021, in McAllen alone, there were fifty-six souls saved. There were many more saved in the ministries in México. In January, we had the Solomon's,

missionaries to Chile here with us (Wendy Solomon is Michelle's sister). One of our churches in Mexico also supports them.

**February was a busy month**. Our son Michael and his family came to visit a few days. Michael preached in both the morning and evening services the 6<sup>th</sup>. Then on the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> we had special messages on "love" during our annual Valentine's celebration. From Feb. 18-23 I was in two missions conferences in the Fort Worth area. We thank God for faithful supporting churches!

In March the Coker's, one of our missionaries in Mexico, were here. We

were blessed by his presentation and preaching! I had an accident that hurt my back that laid me up for a week. The next week we got a stomach flu that put Michelle in the hospital for two days! That is why this letter is late. During the week we were sick, my daughter Darla and 8 of our grandchildren were here and they all got sick too (except for Darla)! They came down for a week of vacation and were sick the whole week! Never a dull moment in the Jones' household!

Since our last letter, we have had 4 saved in services, 9 saved on visitation and 5 baptized! Our average attendance on Sunday mornings was 80 (compared to 100 pre-pandemic). However, we are growing, and our people are excited about the progress there has been in the remodeling of the building at our new place.
