I was able to go to Mexico for a brief time, preaching in two churches and at a special 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary wedding ceremony.

# The work in McAllen:

Since our last letter, we have had <u>15 saved</u>, 7 baptized, and <u>5 more join the church</u>! We had <u>a couple surrender for full</u> <u>time service and another couple to teach our youth!</u> One thing that inspired that couple to take the youth was



the ministry that Melissa Houston began having once a month with our youth. We finally are back to our pre-pandemic attendance. In November, our

average attendance in Sunday School was 103! September was our mission's month. Our faith promise was \$30,000 last year and \$32,005 was given! <u>This year the</u> promise is \$47,775! Pray that we will meet it! Our goal is to have <u>forty missionaries by the end of 2023</u>!

**In October,** the church celebrated our birthdays in a special preacher appreciation service.

**In November** we celebrated **Thanksgiving** on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and we had a record attendance of 148! We were hoping that by the time we wrote this letter we would be in the new building, but ... Even as I write this letter, they are installing the special fire alarm system required by Hidalgo County. As you can see by the photo below, WE NEED THE SPACE!
