This year we have completed four years serving in the small community, El Rancho Viejo (The Old Ranch) where we have bible club every Thursday at 4 pm. She had to have surgery to have the bacteria removed but after the surgery she was unconscious for at least two weeks. When she awoke, she couldn't control her arms and legs at her will. As the days went by little at a time, she was gaining her ability to control her arms, legs and etc. She has attended the bible club once again and she brought a visitor, her mother! Continue to pray for the lost souls in this community.

Please, continue to pray for the construction work of the new church building. We came to a stop for some time but we are moving forward in spite of some setbacks. Pray for Edgar, he is a Christian man, he is an architect (him and his wife have been attending the church with us) and he has a team of men that have been working for these two past weeks on the building.
