Greetings to all our faithful supporters in prayer and financially! We hope everyone is enjoying a wonderful summer. We are excited to share some updates and plans with you.

Visa Update

We are in the process of updating our visas and would appreciate your prayers. The process can be quite costly due to the numerous forms and documentation required to meet government regulations. We are grateful that the country is open to missionaries and does not discriminate against us, which is increasingly uncommon in many European countries. We hope to report soon that this process has been completed.

Attendance and Building Updates

We have welcomed some new visitors in the last couple of months, in addition to our regular attendees. This fall, we are planning more building remodeling projects. We feel blessed to be in a large building located in a good part of town, with a lease of just over \$700 USD per month for the next four years. We have already completed the first year of our lease, and there was a lot of work done to bring the building to its current condition.

Security Enhancements

Our building features two metal roll-up doors at the front—one leading to the entrance and the other to a large window. We recently installed a monitored security system, as we plan to keep one of the roll-up doors open all the time. This will improve visibility from the constant pedestrian traffic. Previously, some people thought we were closed, likely due to the numerous vacancies in the area. For instance, the coffee shop next to us recently closed down.

Upcoming Projects

This fall, one of our primary projects will be installing a pair of French double doors at the entrance of the auditorium. When we leased the building, there were temporary walls creating the large room. These walls will need to be rebuilt as part of the project. Currently, we are using large curtains along one of the sides to where the hallway leads to the back dining area and classroom, but we plan to replace these curtains with temporary walls down the hallway.

This renovation will also allow us to eventually expand the auditorium into the space we are currently using as a storeroom when we are ready.
