“What am I going to do with this time off?” Deputation is a time a learning for new missionaries. One lesson that I have learned is that “time off” in ministry many times will mean “time available”. These three months have held many valuable lessons in flexibility, availability, and contentment in whatsoever state I am.

April was very full! At the start of the quarter, we shared a missions conference in Texas with John and Neila Yelle as well as other missionaries. Part way through the conference I leaend over to my father-in-law John Yelle and ask him, “did you ever think ten years ago that we would be here together?” He leaned over and said, “absolutely not.” It was a joy to reminisce together with how far the Lord has brought us in the last ten years.
