One of the men in the church in Tacoma took care of the services while we were away. We are grateful for Bro Mike Sims and his willingness to keep the church open.

As you all know, we have been working on improvements on the church and also on our home. There is always something else that we would like to see done to both. We also want to go to the coast to see if we could have weekly Bible studies with other tribes. Pray with us about the work here in Washington state. We are not as young as we were when we came here in 1988, but the desire is still the same. We want to reach our people for Christ sake!
