We also saw in April, our highest attendance in Tacoma since we have been back. We had 71 in attendance and a wonderful Easter Sunday. The church has the potential to see growth because we have people who care about other people, and we want to build on that vision for evangelizing in this native community, especially toward the younger generation.

Also on Easter Sunday, we suffered a tremendous loss of our son Benjamin. He was 43 years old and left behind his wife, Anna and three adult children: Isaac, Caleb, and Tawny. He was saved in his early years, so we are grateful for having put his trust in the Lord....if you could put his family on your prayer list, it would be appreciated.

Some of your churches have families that adopt a missionary family to pray for, and we appreciate you. We need you during this sad time in our life.

In May....my wife and I took time off and traveled to the IBFI fellowship in Fort Worth, TX. We have not made those trips too often, but this one was worth the distance.
