I apologize for being so slow in writing again. My days are pretty well consumed with my husband, Leon, in a skilled nursing facility. There are friends and family that give me a break or two every week which is a distinct blessing.

The Accent Radio work, mainly through the lives and work of our students, is going forward. We hear from Mark Alexander that he has taken a job tutoring some students in the English language and thus giving him young men to share the Word with. During the Chinese New Year the schools take a break and he and his wife were going to Hong Kong to visit her parents. Jane's parents are not believers and they were hoping to share the Gospel with them once again. Pray for success.

Unfortunately Leon has hit a plateau and for the past month we have not seen any definite progress. The rehabilitation therapy has been stopped except for restorative therapy, which mainly works at trying to keep the joints limber and some muscle tone in his legs and arms. Leon still has trouble communicating. He tries to speak and sometimes I can understand what he says and sometimes not. It can be very frustrating for him and for me. He is still immobile and his right side is still paralyzed. With a lift we are able to get him into a wheelchair for an hour or so every day. Within a couple of weeks we will probably move him home and bring in outside therapists to continue working on his recovery. Leon is very alert and knows everything that is going on, but just unable to contribute.

Please know that we do appreciate your concern and prayers. Several churches have sent special funds to help with the medical costs and we are very grateful for the help. The Lord has graciously provided all our needs and through all of this I am learning to trust Him more fully. I humbly admit that even though I thought I trusted the Lord, I found that I trusted my husband even more. Now that Leon is not controlling the every day things in our lives, I am learning to **really** trust God in all things. The Lord has been very faithful!

Pray that Leon will start responding to therapy. Pray for me – for patience and strength as I try to care for my husband. Pray that through this trial the Lord will teach us what He wills and that we might conform ourselves more and more to His image.

We love you, our prayer partners, and pray for you. We realize that many of you are also going through trials, many of them more difficult than ours. May God grant you His peace and presence in your lives, as He is doing in our lives.
