Dear Pastor and Friends,

This letter has been a long time in coming, and I apologize. I have been busy as caregiver for my husband. Since the last letter, Leon spent the month of April in hospitals. He became very ill the first week of April and spent 5 days in intensive care until they diagnosed him with a gall bladder infection. Removing the gall bladder and clearing up the infection kept us in hospital settings until the first week of May. Leon is at home now and that is better for both of us. We changed our "den" to accommodate his hospital bed and related equipment and supplies. Leon has improved some in speech but still relies on others for every need. Improvement is so slow that we have had to make some hard decisions.

First of all, Accent International Radio is still helping missionaries in China and other countries who receive funds via AIR. I am continuing the work of Accent, transferring monthly funds to various missionaries. We are keeping a close watch on the work in China and are much encouraged by the news from Mark Alexander. He has been very busy this summer working with pastors to encourage them and connect them with fellow pastors. Each pastor in his little church feels isolated and alone—sort of like Elijah, thinking that he alone is in the fight when there are many others with the same mission. Also, the recent earthquake in China was very close to their city, in fact they felt the quake but did not have the damage. This, they see as an opportunity God will use to "break through the fresh cracks in the lives" of the Chinese people.

This year completes our 50 years of missionary service. We have seen the Lord work in wonderful and exciting ways ... quite often despite us! As far as personal mission work, Leon and I are taking a medical leave of absence. When and if we return to full service is in God's hands. In our 70's now and on the sidelines, we yearn to see young people listen for, step forward in faith and take up the call of missions to a world that desperately needs the Gospel like never before. We want to see the Lord's work go forward, so if you are led by the Lord to use the mission funds we personally receive to support a new missionary preparing for the mission field, please do so with our blessing.

In short, if you currently support Accent International Radio, we pray that you would continue to do so. As far as personal support, however, please follow the Lord's leading.

With thankful hearts, we have been humbled by your steadfast financial support and prayers over the years. We wish we could personally thank each of you face to face, and some day soon, when the trumpet sounds, we will.
