Indian Wells Baptist Church had 22 in their services recently with a man attending that had been prayed over for quite some time. Chambers, Old Paths and Newcomb continue to see growth. Bro. Aaron Nelson and family are doing very well on deputation and are



looking at possible building locations and sites in Crownpoint, NM.
