We have been able to supply personal items as well as Bibles, tracts, Christian publications, and gift cards to the residents and the staff. We are looking forward to being able to hold services there again. We have seen a good number of folks saved there over the years. I also received a message from a blind girl whose family we had helped. She has called in to our services and we are

looking forward to having her come to the service in the near future.





At a recent College chapel, the men were surprised to learn that they would be preaching! They all did a great job! It was good for them to learn being "instant in season, out of season." They have all been challenged to go street preaching. Each male student is required to find a street corner (one with people!!) and preach! It is good for our preachers to stretch themselves and do things they have not before.
