### PREACHING OUT

I had the privilege of being involved in several meetings over the past few months. I was able to preach the Missions Conference for Pastor Isaiah Jackson at Victory Baptist Church of Red Valley on the Navajo Nation. I also preached one night at Victory Baptist in Tuba City for Pastor Brandon Ewer at their Bible Conference. This is a new church plant on the Rez and the Ewers are doing a wonderful job! I was also with my dear friend, Pastor Randy Love, at Grace Baptist in Pittsfield, IL for their Missions Conference. It was a great meeting and a wonderful group of folks! I was also honored to preach at the Missions Conference for Chambers Baptist where my son-in-law David Moncibaiz is the pastor. It was great to see the church commit more for missions than was given last year. I am glad that the Lord allows me to be used of Him to help other churches!



### PASSING OUT

We have restarted church-wide soulwinning on Tuesday nights. We had a Spring Campaign where folks were challenged to see how many tracts and door hangers we could pass out in the community. We also challenged the people to get first-time visitors to the church. When we finished, the people had given out over 1,400 pieces of literature and brought 10 new people to the services. I am excited to report that even though the campaign has ended, we are having more people show up for soulwinning than ever! We have also seen folks saved as a direct result of this. Lord willing, we will be baptizing soon!

### PRESENTING OUT

On Sunday afternoons we have a time of training people who want to disciple others. We were challenged on this when Bro. Hoffmeister preached at the Discipleship Conference in January. We have several folks who are setting appointments with those open to being discipled. One lady who is actually unsaved has had one of our ladies teaching her the discipleship material and has faithfully attended services. Pray for her salvation (we will call her Linda). Another lady asked if she should start discipling someone once she has been discipled! Pray for us as we seek to conserve the fruit God has provided!

### PEERING OUT

As we try to peer into the future of the ministry here, it is great to know that what we call "future" has already been graced with the presence of God. He knows what lies ahead. All we can do is plan and pray and try to have His mind on all we do. Pray for our summer activities as we navigate the restrictions we are under. We plan on having VBS and helping some of the missions with their VBS meetings. Youth Camp is coming up at the end of June. A Men's Camp Out headed up by Missionary Justin Barnett is slated for the end of May. We are also remodeling some of the facilities at Ganado as we prepare to start our Van Ministry back up.
