There were 16 folks saved and two men surrendered to preach! Pastor Stacey Shifflet from Dundalk, Maryland was our main speaker and the Lord used him greatly! A group from his church, Calvary Baptist, came out and passed out over 7,000 gospel tracts. They went with seven different churches here on the Rez. What an encouragement! Also, over \$14,000 was raised to help in a special outreach to Native Alaskans. Bro. Joel Haynes outlined the need among the villages and church plants in Alaska. We are bringing some of the Native Alaskan preachers to our youth camp next year so they can have an opportunity to "catch the fire" and carry it home.
