February was a busy month. I was in a couple missions conferences and also had the privilege of meeting new pastors and friends. One Pastor in particular had been a missionary for many years. He had already retired but one of the church plants was in desperate need of a pastor, so he went back to help. Him and his wife were a huge blessing to me. They knew what it was like visiting churches and starting churches.

March was also a busy month. I had two missions conferences, both in which the other missionaries were friends of mine. I also went to Pensacola, Florida to be with a few churches there. I got to swing by PCC and visit one of my friends who is a member of my church in Fort Worth, Texas.

I have now started to raise money to buy a truck in Mexico. I am looking to get something that blends in with the rest of the crowd, and something that won't break down on me while I drive around. Going from village to village can prove quite difficult on a little car due to the horrible roads, that is why I think it would be best to buy a small 4x4 truck. I pray that by the time I am ready to be there, I would have raised the sufficient amount of money to buy a reliable, small truck.
