Dear Pastor and Church,

These last few months have been great! The Lord has been working in our lives as well as in the lives of those we work with. I have also decided where we will be working independently to start a work. We are getting closer to the final day of working with Iglesia Bautista La Gran Comisión. We have had a great time there with them and have seen the Lord working greatly in the lives of the members at the church.



In April, we had two back-to-back medical brigades. One was in Chunhuhub, and one was in a town called Peto. The Lord allowed a group of Americans to come down and help with the brigade. They brought help, medicines, and the Word was preached. The first day of the brigade was just overwhelming. We had the most we have ever had in a brigade through Agape Clinics. We had close to 200 people come out. Unfortunately, we were not able to tend to everyone at that time, but we did tend to well over 100 people. The next morning, we went to the next town and held a brigade in connection with a small church there. There were maybe around 40 people tended to that day. We also had approximately 14 professions of faith, and all the information of those we helped was given to the local churches.

In May, the Lord allowed me to take a short trip back to the U.S. to the May Fellowship meeting of the IBFI. It was a blessing to be there, and the Lord really worked in my heart through the preachings at the meeting. I was able to catch up with fellow missionaries and brethren in the faith.

June was also filled with much work of the Lord. In June, we had a family conference and had a local pastor come preach for us. It was a beautiful time. A visitor came by and was greatly moved by the sermons. I was able to personally lead him to Christ. He has attended the church on several occasions after the conference. The Lord has also opened doors for me to witness to a young man and also a couple in Felipe Carrillo Puerto. The young man, Carlos, has visited the church a few times in Chunhuhub, but he works in Felipe Carrillo Puerto. Another man in our church is the one who made the contact, and it has now led to visiting with him on Tuesday nights. He is not saved just yet, but he is finally understanding that salvation does not involve his works—only to believe in Jesus. The other couple, who also live in Carrillo, want to see a change in their lives. The same brother from the local church I work with got me in contact with this couple (Ricardo is the name of this brother who has gotten these meetings). The couple's names are Liliana and Axel. Axel is the cousin to one of the cartel leaders in the area. From what I understand, they offered him to work with them, but the Lord is convicting him. I met with them already once and will be meeting with them again on Mondays. I have also been working with another man in the church to take over the young teens' class, and he gave his first lesson on the last Sunday of June. My desire is to slowly transition him into that position to leave behind people that can help the pastor. He will also be leading the outreach we do on Sunday evenings. I have been trying to get the members more involved, and we have started to see more members going out to share the Gospel.



Now, I'd like to take a quick moment to share with y'all what God has put in my heart. I have been praying about where we should start a work, and through prayer and different situations, the Lord has put it in my heart to start another work in Felipe Carrillo Puerto. This town has a couple of good churches, but the town has grown exponentially. Working here will give me close proximity to other co-laborers in Christ, so I believe that God is opening doors here in Carrillo. Please pray for us and what God is doing here.
