Dear Pastor and Church,

The Lord has been so good to us in these last few months. It never ceases to amaze me that God takes so much care of us, and that He would use us to do something for His cause. In these past few months we have been able to see God working in the lives of a few of the people who have been coming to our addictions group. Not only is God working in their lives, but He has been working in ours too!

In January I was able to preach at a church in Merida, Yucatan that was started by American missionaries. They were a blessing to us, and it was a fun time fellowshiping with others in English! We are thankful that God has allowed us to form a friendship with them. We also continued our weekly gatherings for the addictions. We saw God bring people to the group that were able to hear the Gospel.



In February, I was able to teach a young married couple from a local church as they are preparing for ministry. Their pastor, Alfredo Pech, asked me to help teach a theology class with them. It was an honor to participate in helping prepare this young marriage for ministry. We had about 10 classes together. I thoroughly enjoyed teaching them. The husband, "Chucho" as they call him here, preached for the first time in front of his church this past Sunday (March 29<sup>th</sup>). He preached on some of the attributes of God, which we had gone over in their class. In February, we also were able to lead a man to the Lord that we have been working with. He and his wife drink often. Like many marriages here, violence was part of this relationship. We were

later able to talk to him after a few days and he admitted he was wrong. We witnessed to him and he accepted Christ as his personal Saviour. They still have a long way to go and grow, but the Lord has opened the door with them.



In March, we had a young man visit the group that I invited from a coffee shop that I often visit. He went twice, and is interested in attending, just has a hard time with work. Pray that the Lord may use us to bring him to Christ. In March we also started preparing for April because we will be starting our first church service on April 5<sup>th</sup>. Towards the end of the month, we were able to visit *Iglesia Bautista Resurrección* in Merida, Yucatan at their missions



conference. They bought us our first 500 personalized tracks, of which I was excited to get back and hand out! It was such a blessing to see what God is doing there, and their missions conference was such an encouragement to us. Another exciting thing that happened in March is that one of the young ladies visiting the group got saved. To not make the story too long, my pastor friend Octavio and his wife led her to the Lord. Please continue to hold the rope! God is working!
