We have no right to expect God to bless the preaching of wrongly divided Scripture. We see God move mightily when the word is preached as He gave it to us.

Yet some do not believe. The Bible is filled with examples of both belief and unbelief in the Word Preached. In Matthew 13:58, we learn of something powerful enough to limit Jesus. *And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.* It is pitiful! It is prevalent! It is personal! Faith must start with me. *For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.* Romans 1:17

Let us determine to *Buy the truth, and sell it not* and then let us preach it until Jesus returns or calls us home! Let God's next mighty work begin with you and me!
